Buckets is run by WPIAL Boys Varsity Head Coach, Justin Walther. Walther just finished his second year at Plum and has been a Head Coach in the WPIAL for 8 years, including a WPIAL FINALS appearance in 2019 at Serra Catholic. Walther has a 104-80 record as a Head Coach.

Pittsburgh Buckets is also coached by former collegiate basketball player Sarah Merlina and Elizabeth Forward Boys Varsity Coach Nolan Larry. Larry is into his 3rd season at Elizabeth Forward and is finishing his 20th year in coaching. Merlina is a grad student at Geneva College and has coached the past 3 seasons with the Buckets program.

Players will receive (2x) 1 hour to 1 hour and 15 minute practices/week and at least 4 tournaments for the upcoming Spring/Summer session. The program runs from the beginning of March to the end of June.
